Type of seller, buyer, importer, exporter can be PRIVATE or BUSINESS

Terms: (DAP, EDAP)

Country for seller, buyer, importer, exporter can be GB or UK

Naming convention

Exporter- Company who is sending the packages, the address should be same like in label!

Exporter – same data as in the sender object provided in the DPD Services call.

Importer- Is the person who is receiver of the package (the address should be same like in label).

Importer – same data as in the receiver object provided in the DPD Services call.

Seller and Buyer to be used only in the case when seller ships via their partner.

Seller- Company who is selling products. This is used when customer is different than the exporter.
