PVA (Postponed VAT Accounting)

Once your request has been registered with DPD UK, DPD can clear the goods through customs using your PVA number.

Benefits :

- Simplifies invoicing between all parties involved
- Speeds up the customs clearance & delivery process
- Advance payment of VAT by DPD UK
- Facilitates procedures → The C79 certificate will be supplied directly by HMRC to our customers.

To benefit from this solution :

- Complete and return the required document signed to dutyandvatcollection@dpgroup.co.uk
- Have a valid UK EORI number
- For DAP shipments, the importer must authorise DPD UK to clear the goods through customs using their Deferment Account Number (DAN).

DAP (without DAN) :

To date, the payment notifications do not identify the PVA solution implemented.

As a result, the recipient will receive notification to pay the full VAT.

BUT, this amount will be refunded in full if the PVA solution has been validated by DPD UK.

DAP (with DAN) :

DPD UK can clear goods through customs using the PVA with a DAN number.

Deferment Account Number (DAN)

DPD UK can clear goods through customs using your DAN number.

This facilitates customs clearance and provides an optimal customer experience.

Preferential Origin

At present, DPD UK allows customs clearance of goods manufactured in the European Union, up to a value of £1,000 per product.

To benefit from preferential origin, a customs invoice is required, specifying the origin for each product.
